

Hungarian-Czech Talks Due

PRAGUE, Czechoslovakia, Jan. 19 (U.P.)—Dr. James Gyoengyoesy, Hungarian Foreign Minister, will arrive in Prague next week to renew negotiations, broken off last December, for an exchange of Hungarian and Slovak minorities, usually well-informed sources said today. The Foreign Ministry partially confirmed the report, saying that Mr. Gyoengyoesy was expected, but not explaining the nature or date of his visit.
