Greetings to our boys. A conservative policy when even Germany [is to be] a republic impossible [,] would foster blind radicalism. Stop. Boys will want to go home perhaps it will be possible but must act in accord with allies and cannot leave Russia without providing allied troops in our stead if we stay this sacrifice will tell at the peace conference. Stop. Boys will understand that just now unity of whole army and order is absolutely necessary. Stop. English government asks me to intervene; guida<sup>2</sup>
